Post of Transport Sector Specialist

Educational qualification and Experience: Candidate should possess a

- a) A degree from a university recognized by the University Grants Commission in Civil/Transport Engineering, Construction Management , Transport Planning or other relevant field
- b) Approximately 10 years of professional experience in planning and managing the development and implementation of transport project that involve design, construction or maintenance with a demonstrated ability to deliver large complex projects on a tight time line. Familiarity with various aspects of projects development including pre-feasibility or feasibility studies, cost estimating, designing and /or construction supervision is preferred.
- c) Detailed knowledge of the road transport sector policies, policy making institutions and construction industry in Sri Lanka. Familiarity with Sri Lanka's road transport sector strategy, master plan/ or strategic investments plan strongly preferred.
- d) Demonstrated ability to interact effectively and constructively with public policy makers, civil society organizations, and technical and construction experts and project affected parties.
- e) Appropriate professional licensure or Project Management Professional (PMP) is preferred.

Qualification and Experience:

- a) A degree in Finance / Accountancy / Commerce / Financial Management / Business Administration / Public Administration which is recognized by the U.G.C.

AND

A minimum three years post qualifying experience in the field of accountancy after obtaining the first degree.

OR

- b) Having passed the Intermediate Examination of a recognized professional Institute (ICASL/CIMA/ACCA or any other equivalent qualifications of a relevant professional body)

AND

A minimum three years post qualifying experience in Accountancy in public Service, a Corporation, Statutory Board/Institute or a reputed Private Institution in a relevant field

OR

- c) Having obtained a certificate of higher National Diploma in Accountancy (HNDA)

AND

A minimum of three years post qualification experience in public service, a Corporation, Statutory Board/Institution or a reputed Private Institution in a relevant field

OR

- d) An officer of the Government All Island Services Class II or above with experience in relevant field.

Age Limit : Should be below 45 years

Other Terms and conditions:

The remuneration will be paid in terms of the Management services Circular No.01/2016 issued on 24.03.2016 on cadre and Remuneration Management of projects.

- Officers who are in the service will be recruited on secondment basis.
